

WHAT CAN I DO IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD TO PROMOTE ATTRACTIVE CURBSIDE APPEAL?

1. Sweep up your grass clippings after mowing your lawn – this is becoming a big problem in the neighborhood (unattractive)
2. Hide your trash cans - move your trash cans so that they are out of sight of neighbors and visitors (e.g. Place in garage or in backyard). No garbage cans in front of or on side of homes for neighborhood curb appeal.
3. Do not place your trash out until the evening before trash pickup. Trash cans must be off of the street within 24 hrs. of trash pickup. If you will be out of town, make arrangements to have it moved. Trash cans cannot remain on street until the next pick up date.
4. Park idle vehicles in your garage. Park your operable vehicle in your driveway and not on the street – this will be strictly enforced starting in January 1, 2017. Vehicles will be towed at owner's expense. Please do your part and help keep abandoned vehicles off the street and in driveways. If they are not properly tagged or creating an unsightly appeal to the neighborhood, go to Mayor Action Center – **www.indygov.org and complete the abandon vehicle form. You can remain anonymous.**
5. Park the vehicle you drive day-to-day in your driveway or garage.
6. Attend the neighborhood meetings
7. Slow down when driving in neighborhood (**adhere to posted speed limit 30mph**).
8. When walking in the neighborhood, everyone should use sidewalks.
9. Turn your music down when you come into the neighborhood after dusk.
10. Report any illegal activity to the neighborhood help line 767-0074, anonymously. Reported activity will be monitored through our [Crime Watch](#) Courtesy Patrol Service.
